1. Sykes's Veredon Another Rose. Brindle pup I have judged before. Correct in head neck and shoulder, good front and bone, deep rib, strong loin, well made quarters while balanced throughout. She was a little unsettled moving but went ok. Has a bright future.
2. Rees & Jones's Kierpark You Are My Sunshine. ANother cracking pup with good bone and balance. Feminine head, good in neck and shoulder, nice tuck up, good quarters, moved well.
3. Lancashire & O'Donnell's If The Crown Fits Drishaun

1. Whitehead, Smith & Mixdies Citycroft Storm In A Teacup. Brindle fawn, feminine head, sound front with good fill for age. Correct length, well made quarters which she used to advantage. Moved well. BPB
2. Beetie's Beetelian Jewel In The Crown. Fawn with good bone and front. While a nice type, tends to fall away affecting her topline

1. Allisstone's Hergehill With Bells On. An elegant brindle parti. Lovely head, neck and shoulder, well filled front, deep rib, nice length, strong loin, correct tuck up, well made quarters, moved well.
2. Aincough's Kidaruka Mother Of Mine. Similar type of fawn to 1. While difficult to separate I just preferred head of 1. Moved soundly.
3. Saxby's Runaround Amazing Grace With Sandspring

1. Howgate & Hull's Palmik Queen Of Diamonds JW. Smart feminine brindle parti. Lovely size and balance, good neck and shoulders with a well filled front. Good bone, deep rib, strong loin, good quarters and angulation. Moved soundly and with purpose.
2. Beetie's Beetlian Krispy Kreme. A dark brindle with correct head neck and shoulders. Sound front, well developed rib, strong loin, moved out well with good quarters. Just preferred size of 1.
3. Moore's Zoraden Secret Sins At Sunwalkers

1. Whitaker-Crosby's Crosscop May Be One More At Mulcair. Loved this fawn parti. Has a feminine head, good in neck and shoulder, deep rib, well filled front, good length, strong loin, nice tuck, well developed quarters used well. With maturity one to watch.
2. Webster's Zoraden Fifty Shades Darker. A vlack shown in first class order. Correct all through. Moved well, I just preferred head of 1.
3. Howgate & Hull's Brynreia Whispered Love At Palmik

1. Smith's Welstar Airs And Graces At Cryhavoc. A balanced, correct sized fawn. Loved her head, good neck with well laid back shoulders. Well filled rib, strong loin, sound quarters, moved well.
2. Julian's Blondessa Be Happy JW. Another quality fawn. Sound all through, great for size, very feminine and moved well.
3. Head's Demerlay Strawberry Ice JW

LB - Best Class of the day

1. Wood's Ardencote Aiming High. Judged her before as a puppy. Loved her then awarding her BP. She has turned into a super whippet having type and balance. Feminine head, good neck and shoulders, well filled front with well made ribs. Strong loin, nice tuck up, sound well made quarters, moved very well, no exaggerations. Well done on BCC / BIS.
2. Brown's Ardencote Sweet Destiny For Bluestreak. Very similar type to 1 with little separating these two. I just preferred length of 1.
3. Glaholm's Gazenorth Secret Identity

1. Sykes's Veredon Geeuz A Gander. A quality pale fawn, good head neck and shoulder, deep well filled front, good bone, deep rib with firm loin, nice quarters, good angulation, went well both ways. Pushed hard for top honours, RCC. Her day will come.
2. Brown's Ardencote Star Maker. Yet another quality fawn, sound all through, nicely made and moved well.
3. Lain & Alexander's Lolani Tennessee Honey

1. Place & Haliday's Ch. Collooney Queen Of Dragons With Brochinbelle JW. Really lovely fawn and white, very nice type indeed being sound all through with excellent movement.
