BITCHES

Thank you to the officers and committee for inviting me to judge bitches at their open show and to the exhibitors who braved the snow to come to the show. I had a lovely quality entry throughout the classes making for some difficult decisions. My co-judge and I agreed on most of the 'in show' awards. BPIS Mixides Railfield Ranicon of Yialousa – handsome young dog of 8 months with appealing expression, good ears, long neck and well laid shoulders, ideal for size and a lovely shape, with good angulation front and rear. Moved well with drive.

MPB (1)

1. Willow's Shalfleet Sky Diamond Fawn and white of 8 months. Lovely size and shape, pretty head and feminine expression and good rose ears, long neck and well placed shoulders. Good length of body and deep brisket, good angulation front and rear, well-muscled for age and moved well with drive. BPB

PB (5 2a)

1. Seers Espinore Elegant Miss. Elegant fawn and white parti, feminine head and gentle expression, long neck and well placed shoulders, good angulation front and rear, good length of body and bend of stifle. Moved well in the class but naughty in the challenge.
2. Leatharts Molvine Zoe. White who was close up to winner, sweet head and expression, long neck and good shoulders, elegant all through, although would prefer more spring of rib, good length of body and good muscletone.
3. Glasspool & Manners Bonny Roamer at Mannerpool

JB (5 2a)

1. Mycroft' Supeta's Eclipse JW . Top quality young fawn and white who stands presenting a graceful flowing outline. Feminine head with oval eye, alert expression and good rose ears. Long elegantly arched neck flowing into well laid shoulders and correct front angulation. Well sprung ribs and good depth of brisket. Stands over enough ground with a lovely length of loin. Well muscled hind quarters, correct rear angulation and low hocks giving plenty of drive from behind coupled with extended daisy cutting action enabled her to move round the ring as if she owned it and today she did. Shown in lovely coat and condition, well handled BB & BIS
2. Lain & Alexander's Lolani Magic Fire Diamond Brindle and white with lovely head and eye, long neck and good shoulder placement, lovely length of body and correct outline. With good rear angulation and bend of stifle.
3. Glasspool & Manners Bonny Roamer at M

YB (7 3a) Close decision between 1 & 2.

1. Wilton Clark' Shalfleet Sugar Frosting JW. Quality brindle and white of ideal size, pretty head, lovely expression and neat ears. Elegant neck leading to correctly placed shoulders and good front angulation. Good depth of brisket, spring of rib and length of loin. Moved very well with good front extension and drive from behind holding her topline.
2. Jones Welstar Heaven Sent, Another quality b, lovely head with good under jaw and gentle expression. Long neck and well laid shoulders and good angulation front and rear. Lovely length of

body with deep brisket, good in fill and spring of rib. Moved well, in lovely condition.

3. Stock's Belle's Beauty of Shemist

NB (7 3a)

1. W Heaven Sent.

2. Williamson's Windfly Over The Rainbow, Black in gleaming condition who stood over plenty of ground. Good head and eye, long elegant neck to lovely topline with good length of loin. Deep brisket and good spring of rib. Well muscled hind quarters and good bend of stifle. Moved well.

3. L Fire Diamond

PGB

1. Hills Shimmeree Blue Denim Quality, elegant blue of lovely size and shape, who stands naturally over plenty of ground. Pretty head, gentle expression with good under jaw and neat ears. Long elegant neck leading to good shoulder placement and well angulated front. Deep brisket and good spring of rib and good infill. Good angulated rear with well muscled hind quarters. Lovely bend of stifle with low hocks. Moved well with plenty of drive. Shown in lovely coat and condition. RBB & RBIS on referees decision

2. Bennetts Stormburst Wild Fern brindle and white, pretty head and appealing expression, good ears, long neck and well placed shoulders, lovely length of body with good spring of rib and deep brisket. Good bend of stifle and muscletone moved well.

3. Lloyd's Cederidge Far Ahead

LB (13. 7a) Lovely class

1. Julian's Bluestreak Blonde Ambition. Elegant fawn of ideal size with a lovely outline. Feminine head and expression, good length of neck and shoulder placement, correct angulation front and rear, lovely length of body, deep brisket and good spring of rib. Moved very well with good front extension and plenty of drive from behind. Shown in lovely coat and condition.

2. De Lacey Munday's Whipowil Sea Anenome Anenome fawn of lovely size, feminine head and gentle expression, good length of neck and well placed shoulders and well angulated front. Lovely outline, good infill, deep brisket spring of rib, and length of loin. Moved well.

3. Leatharts' Ringmore Fair Rosamund

OB (7. 3a) Wonderful class, 4 lovely bitches and was really splitting hairs to separate them.

1. Mycrofts Supeta's Dazzalicious JW Have loved this b since I saw her in the puppy classes and I was not disappointed in her today. Brindle and white of ideal size and a lovely outline, she has a feminine head, lovely expression and good rose ears. Lovely reach of neck and good shoulder placement, deep brisket and good spring of rib. Lovely length of loin, well muscled hind quarters and good bend of stifle. Moved well with drive. Not co-operating with her new handler in the challenge.

2. Bennetts Stormburst Wild Honey JW. Brindle of high quality, ideal size and shape, pretty head, good under jaw and lovely expression, long neck and well laid shoulders, good depth of brisket and spring of rib. Good angulation front and rear. Lovely muscletone, moved well.

3. Hills Shimmeree Black Winceyette

R/C B (7 3a)

1. R Fair Rosamond fawn of correct size, feminine head and sweet expression, long neck leading to well placed shoulders and front angulation. Deep brisket and good spring of rib giving plenty of heart room. Shown in fit condition with well muscled hind quarters and good second thigh. Moved well in profile.

2. Grants Windfly Fairy Dust Fawn with white trim, wouldn't want her any bigger but still well

balanced with good head and expression, long neck and good shoulders. Good length of body and deep brisket, good bend of stifle, moved with drive.

3.W Over the Rainbow

SBB (8 5a)

1. Wignalls Starswift Sunbeam. Fawn Pretty head and sweet expression, Long neck, good shoulders, bone and depth of brisket and spring of rib. Lovely topline with good length of loin and good rear angulation. Shown in good coat and condition. Moved best in the class.

2.Bunney's Bunehug On Reflection. Brindle. Good head with sweet expression and good ears. Nice for size and shape with a good outline, depth of brisket and bend of stifle, well muscled hindquarters and low hocks.

3. Glasspool & Manners Bonny Roamer at M

VB (10 4a)

1. Seers Espinore Elegant Lady. Well named quality fawn, lovely head, feminine expression and neat ears. Long neck and well placed shoulders and good front angulation. Lovely length of body, deep brisket, good infill and well sprung ribs. Good bend of stifle and low hocks. Moved very well with plenty of drive both coming and going and in profile with good front extension. A credit to her owners. Considered her for RBB. BVB BVIS

2.Ringmore Cut Glass Well balanced fawn of ideal size and shape, sweet head with gentle expression, good length of neck and shoulder placement. Deep brisket and good length of loin. Good coat and condition, moved well.
