Dogs

I would like to thank the officers and committee for this appointment and for the kind and generous hospitality shown to us on the day. The quality of the dogs was excellent.

Minor puppy (4,1)

Three lovely babies. All at different stages of their development.

1. Mixides' Railfield Rainicon in Yialousa. 7 months old and very eye catching. Very together. Nice angles at the front. Forechest still developing. Plenty of depth to chest and well ribbed back. Good length to back. Strong loin. Rear angulation in good proportions to the front. All this allows him to move well and with purpose. Best Puppy Dog. Pleased that my co-judge agreed for him to go BPIS. With care he should have a bright future.
2. Price's Ashvilleebur Royal Command among Silkdance. Also 7 months old but more immature. Nice shape to him. Good bone. Enough neck. Front assembly good and rear in balance. Like him on the stack but not as free as 1st on the move. Again, shows promise.
3. Wilton-Clark's Shalfleet Skyfall. 8 months.

Puppy (4,2)

1. Wilton-Clark's Shalfleet Sky Blue. Up to size and this allows for his immaturity. Nice head carriage on long neck. Clean shoulders and fair return to upper arm. Plenty of depth and well ribbed back. Strong loin, good tail carriage. Good angles allow him to drive from the rear. Like his brother in Minor Puppy looks promising.
2. Seers' Espinore Eagle Rock. A finer puppy throughout but showing quality. Well made but not making the most of himself today.

Junior (7,4)

1. Mycroft's Supeta's Breaking Dawn. A more refined dog with good bone. I like his outline on the stack. Good head and eye shape. Nice ears. Strong neck. Good in topline. Good angulation front and rear and in balance with each other. This along with correct muscle tone allowed him to excel in movement which won him this class.
2. Mixides' Star Gazing Over Yialousa. A bigger dog all through. I preferred the head and outline of my first, otherwise a nicely made dog.
3. Knights & Stokes' Lelaps Lumos Maxima.

Yearling (6,2)

1. Welsh's Chrispan Star Turn. Not surprised to hear that one and two are brothers and they have very similar attributes. A handsome dog of good proportions. I liked his head shape, showing strength of underjaw. Good pigment and eye shape. Nice ears. Strong long neck which he used well. Nicely made front with plenty of heart room, needed in a running dog. Good forechest, well ribbed back and nicely sprung. Good length to back and strong loin with correct rear. Plenty of length from hip to hock. Used his attributes to best advantage, moving true and sound and showing good extension and drive. I shall watch his career with some interest. Best Dog.
2. Brown's Chrispan Celtic Legand of Hazeacre. So many of his brother's qualities. Well put together and used to advantage. Hair splitting decisions. Another to watch.
3. Mixides' Citycroft Star Gazing Over Yialousa.

Post Graduate (4,2)

1. Cutter & Lubin's Wayhead Cellini for Chosovi JW. Refined dog of good bone. Strong neck. Clean shoulders. Good depth to chest. Nice topline and strong loin. Well muscled. Moving well.
2. Wignall's Collooney Stay With Me at Starswift. Another nice dog. Different shape and type to one. I preferred this one's head for shape but stuffier in neck. Nice front with good depth to chest. Good length from hip to hock. Stands well over the ground..

Limit (11,4)

A very nice class.

1. Welsh's Sejoda Walking In Memphis. Liked his head. Good shape to eyes and ears. Strong neck into clean shoulders. Very good in forechest. Good depth to chest and well ribbed. Good length to back and strong loin. Well angled rear. Sound mover who extends and drives well. Reserve Best Dog.
2. Brown's Chrispan Crazy Diamond of Hazeacre. Pushed one hard. Difficult to separate. Head shape and balance good. Strong neck. Well angled front assembly and good forechest. Well ribbed back and strong loin. Rear compliments front and both used well on the move.
3. De Lacey Munday's Whipowil Sea Lord.

Open (3,2)

1. Clarke & Moore's Yialousa Frisco Bay at Sunwalkers. Stood alone but a very nice dog. I like his head and eye colour. Strong neck. Good angles to front and rear assemblies. Nice forechest and good spring to ribs. Strong loin. Sound on the move and nice gait.

Special Racing/Lure Coursing (2)

1. Wayhead Cellini for Chosovi JW.

2. Price's Elanash Majestic Gold Among Silkdance JW. Like this nicely made dog. He is a lovely shape on the stack. More refined throughout. Angles in front balance rear allowing him to present a nice picture on the move.

Special Beginners (5,1)

1. Elanash Majestic Gold Among Silkdance JW.

2. Clarke & Moore's Bluestreak Bright Side Among Sunwalkers. Another whose shape I liked. A refined dog of good angles. Sound on the move.

3. Cutter & Lubbin's Nightshade Sapphire for Chosovi.
